PORTRAIT OF AN AMERICAN #2 by FRITZ SCHOLDER

During the summer of 1973, Fritz Scholder, noted American artist, drew the image for the lithograph PORTRAIT OF AN AMERICAN #2 at the Tamarind Institute in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

The edition for this 30" x 22" print consists of two states: the first state is black on buff Arches paper numbering 50; the second state is red and blue on white Arches paper numbering 57. The artist has donated 25 prints of each state with the authorization that the lithographs be sold at a pre-publication price of \$350.00 as a major part of the Phoenix Art Museum League's fund raising activities.

The lithograph was hand printed at Tamarind, world known for its excellence in fine art lithography. Each print is signed and numbered by the artist and bears the embossed "chop" of Tamarind, the master printer and the artist. The lithographic stones upon which the drawings were made, have been defaced and documented guaranteeing the existence of a limited number of impressions.
